The author of this hymn, George Young, (1903), was a carpenter and a pastor. He didn't make much money in either profession. Most of his life was spent in small farming communities. Finally, however, he and his wife were able to build their own home, and they moved in. Shortly afterwards, while the Youngs were holding meetings in another small town, someone set fire to their house, and it was reduced to ashes.

It was probably out of that experience that Young wrote this hymn and ended the chorus with these words: "Some thru great sorrow but God gives a song. In the night season and all the day long."
