Fredrick Blom remembered well the day when prison gates clanged shut behind him and he was incarcerated. He deserved it, and he knew it. As a minister of the gospel there was no excuse for him. He had emigrated from Sweden to America, joined the Salvation Army, and later became a minister in the Evangelical Covenant Church. Then he feel into sin. He wrote about it later: "I drifted from God and became embittered with myself, the world, and not the least with ministers who looked on me with suspicion because I was a member of the Socialist party." It took a term in prison to remind him of God's great and wondrous love. God could still forgive, even the sin of a pastor who had betrayed his calling. Shortly after he was let out of prison he wrote this hymn about the gates of heaven, pearly gates that would open, even for someone like Fredrick Blom.

Love divine, so great and wondrous, deep and mighty, pure, sublime, Coming from the heart of Jesus--j ust the same through tests of time. 2. God has given you His promise, that He hears and answers prayer; He will heed your supplication, if you cast on Him your care.

3. Love Divine, so great and wondrous, all my sins He then forgave. I will sing His praise forever, for His blood, His power to save. 4. In life's eventide, at twilight, at His door I'll knock and wait, By the precious love of Jesus, I shall enter heaven's gate.
