Most people look at Genesis, chapter five as a boring list of "begats." But if you look at the meaning of each name from Adam to Noah, it is hard not to be touched by God's

Adam=Man; Seth=Appointed; Enosh=Mortal; Kenan=Sorrow; Mahalalel=The Blessed God; Jared=Shall come down; Enoch=Teaching; Methuselah=His death shall bring; Lemech=The despairing; Noah=Comfort. Reading the English meanings to the Hebrew names: Man (is) appointed the mortal sorrow; (but) the Blessed God shall come down, teaching (that) His death shall bring the despairing comfort (or rest).

This is the gospel in a nutshell as spelled out by God from the beginning.

The message of 1 Corinthians 13:6-7 is evident throughout the Bible.

The Christ has always been protecting, trusting, hoping, and preserving.
